

APPLICATION TO GRADUATE

Final-year students who have successfully completed or are about to complete a program of study must complete this "application to graduate" form. By completing the form, the student requests the University to confirm their eligibility to graduate with a university award and to include their name on the graduation list for conferring their award during the graduation ceremony. It is important that you complete this form and enter the correct information about yourself and the program you have completed or about to be complete. A graduation application fee of K250.00 must be paid as it applies to those graduating in person or in absentia. This application fee is separate and does not cover the cost of your graduation attire.

This form must be received by the 31st of December before the conferring of your award in March.
